

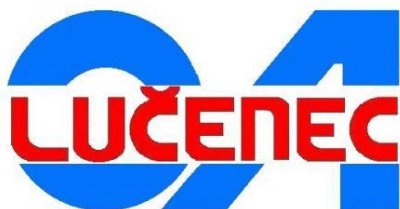

The description of the commercial and marketing strategy,

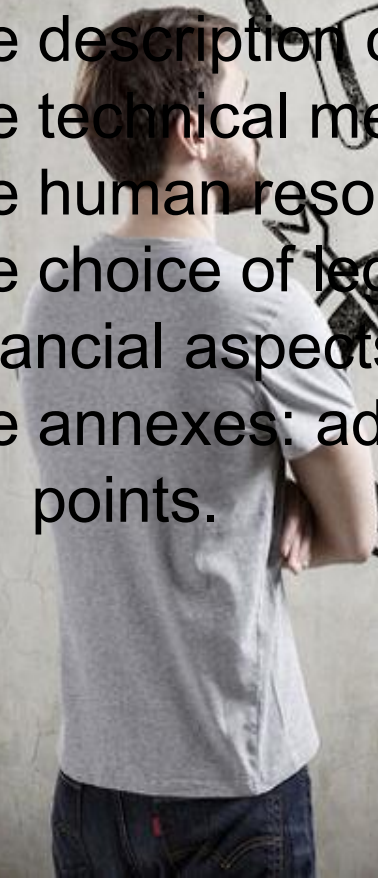
The technical means that are planned,

The responsibilities, the social system or the taxation can change completely at all.

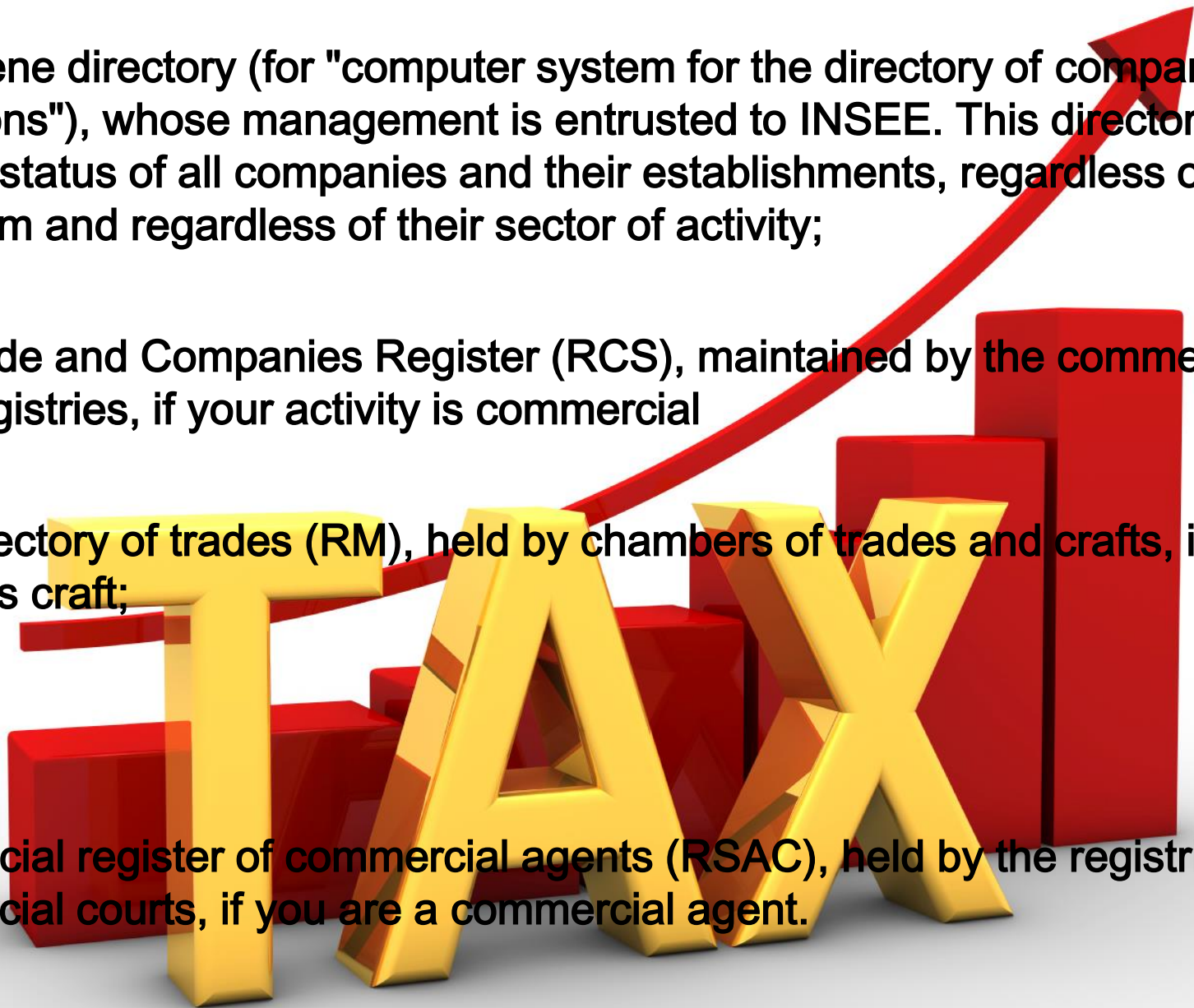
DECLARATIONS AND REGISTRATIONS

The Sirene directory (for "computer system for the directory of companies and institutions"), whose management is entrusted to INSEE. This directory records the civil status of all companies and their establishments, regardless of their legal form and regardless of their sector of activity;

The Trade and Companies Register (RCS), maintained by the commercial court registries, if your activity is commercial

The directory of trades (RM), held by chambers of trades and crafts, if your activity is craft;

The special register of commercial agents (RSAC), held by the registries of commercial courts, if you are a commercial agent.



To help for business creation :

The **CFE** Centre de Formalité des entreprises (business formality center) to simplify all these steps.

The CFE's mission is to simplify your administrative procedures at the time of creation, modification or termination of your activity.

A single declaration is sufficient to complete all your administrative, legal, social and tax procedures for all concerned organisations
